Derbyshire Country Link would like to invite you to attend the National Weekend to be held at The Royal Britannia Hotel, 170 Ferensway, Kingston upon Hull HU1 3UF. The Hotel is next to the Paragon Railway station and the Hull Paragon Interchange, although, there is car parking (£5.00 per 24hours), why not travel by rail and 'let the train take the strain?' For those members who fly to the Weekends, the Humber Flyer bus service connects the Humberside Airport with the Hull Paragon Interchange, contact Traveline (08712002233 or their web site for further details).

The cost of the Weekend is £155 per person for a twin or double room, a limited number of single rooms are available at a supplement of £15 per night. This covers dinner, bed and breakfast on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, entertainment on all nights and the cost of the coaches on Saturday. Not included in the price is the cost of entrance fees at the venues on Saturday and Sunday or any midday meals.

Friday night entertainment will be a hot buffet supper followed by a Disco or Band Dance
The Fancy Dress theme is "Wigs" so let your imagination run riot.

On Saturday the trips we are hoping to have included the following:
